



Towards European database: the goals

- 1. Learn from outcomes: track what goes well and what has room for improvement.
- 2. Steer on fidelity: Explain differences in fidelity score on an item-level: country differences or are we assessing differently?
- 3. Qualitative country specific insights: Explain differences between countries and share challenges and solutions.
- 4. European numbers: Give an impression of the overall results of IPS in Europe.

Fidelity

Average total and item-scores of the <u>most recently completed</u> fidelity assessment of all IPS programs in the country (once every 6 months)



Outcomes and disclaimer

Outcome data for Q2 (april-june) 2023 available from 5 countries:

- Norway
- Italy
- France
- Belgium
- The Netherlands

Important notes:

- 1. Not all data is entirely complete or reliably checked \rightarrow small differences in current outcomes are possible!
- 2. The shared data is solely used to give insights and to learn! It is not a competition nor an evaluation of the implementation of IPS in specific countries!

10,917 The number of clients receiving IPS in our 5 countries


42,0% The competitive employment rate in our 5 countries

101.0 The average fidelity score




Number of clients and IPS specialists per country






Employment rate per country






Number of clients that started and stopped employment per country






Drop-out per country

Fidelity item scores Top 3 **best** scoring items 1. Diversity of employers (item 20) 2. Diversity of job types (item 19) 3. Time-unlimited follow-along supports (item 23) Top 3 worst scoring items 1. Job development—Frequent employer contact (item 17) 2. Community-based services (item 24) 3. Integration through frequent team contact (item 5) Top 3 items with *biggest country differences* 1. Assertive engagement and outreach by integrated treatment team (item 25) 2. Community-based services (item 24) 3. Integration through team assignment (item 4)
