Important Information

Rules and Restrictions of the hospital

Thursday: Please bring a negative Corona rapid test certificate to the conference (<24h old) on day 1 – Thursday 27th October.

You can get this for 3 € in pharmacies or mobile test stations. There is a mobile test station on the left in front of the hospital. The test result applies for both Thursday and Friday of the conference. At the pharmacies or at the test station you will receive a certificate (digital or paper) of the result of the test. You will then carry this to the conference venue at the hospital and potentially show the hospital this certificate.

Wearing a mask is mandatory on public transport and throughout the conference. Masks must fulfil the requirements of FFP2. Only speakers are allowed to remove their masks during the presentation.
