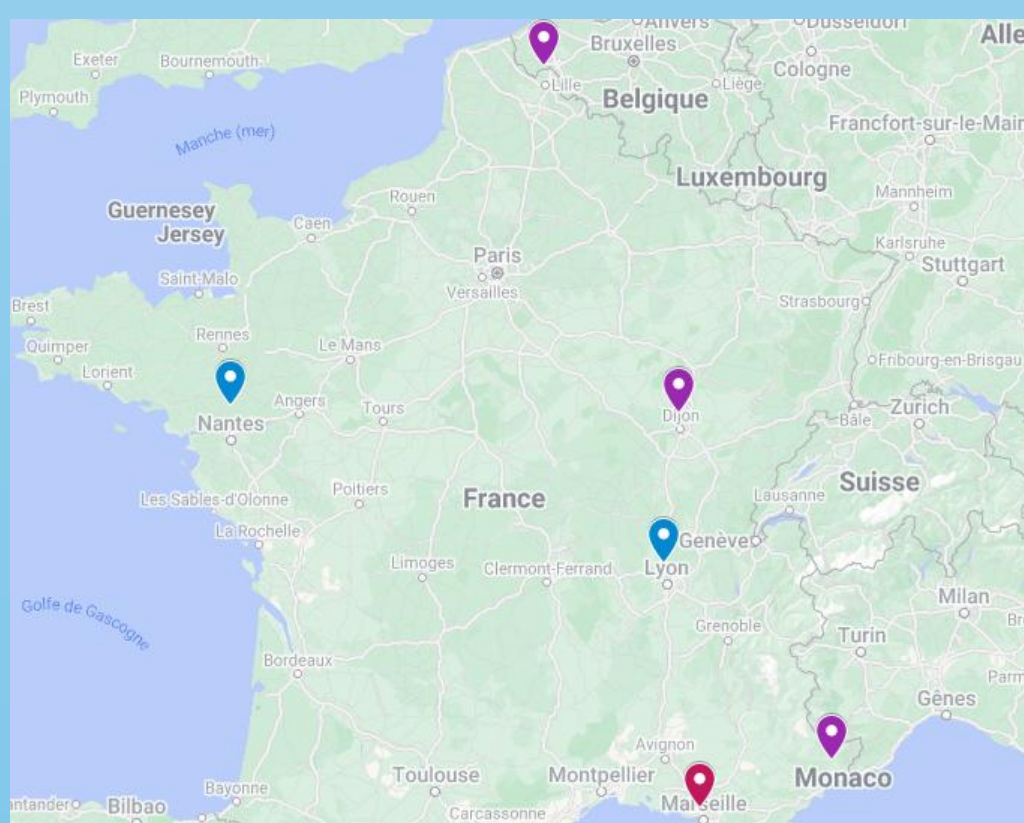


FAIR Fidelity score
